Dear Parent/Guardian,

Re: ANNUAL SPORTS DAY – 2025

On behalf of the Children, Staff and Management of Kampala Kindergarten Association, I officially invite you to attend the KKA Annual Sports Day which is scheduled for **Saturday April 12, 2025 from 8:30am to 1:00pm** at the **Y.E.S Sports Centre - Nsambya**.


Please take note of the following:

1. Parents will drop their children at the field by 8:00am. The KKA staff will be there from 7:30am to receive them.
2. The sports activities will begin at 8:30am. Please keep time so that your child does not miss any of them.
3. All children shall wear their sports uniforms, white socks and canvas shoes on Saturday. In order for parents to wash the Sports uniforms, children will wear their dotted uniforms on Friday April 11, 2025.
4. All children will march in classes. However, the children of Green, Blue and Primary One will compete in their respective Houses namely: Power Rangers, Marshal Rangers and Supermen. The children of Yellow and Red (1D, 1C, 1B, 1A & 2D) will be given an opportunity to perform in their respective classes.
5. The following clubs will be given a chance to perform at the function: Cubs and Brownies, Muslim Network, Christian Network, MDD, Aerobics and Amazon. Parents should get in touch with the Class teachers /Club patrons for details. However, the Management is reminding those who have not yet paid to do so before the function.
6. Only Old Boys and Girls in KKA alumni uniforms will be given a chance to march and participate in some of the Sports day activities. We also request parents that have school T-shirts to wear them and be part of the day activities. Alumni's T-shirts are on sale at Ugx 20,000/= and parents' T-shirts at Ugx 30,000/= only.
7. The school will provide the children of KKA with a break meal at 10:30am. All children are expected to have taken breakfast before leaving home in the morning.
8. Under the Management of Y.E.S Sports Centre – Nsambya, Soft drinks and snacks will be on sale at the field for parents, alumni and well-wishers in attendance. However, for safety and security purposes, we request you not to feed the KKA children until the end of the sports activities.
9. Parents are requested to sign-in their children as they hand them over to the teachers and sign them out as they get them back after the sports activities. A gate pass will be given to every parent taking the child out of the field.
10. Since outside sellers increase security risks at the field, we have not invited them. We therefore request parents not to promote them by buying their eats and toys when the sports activities are still going on. We shall request them to parade their commodities at the gate of the field so that you can buy whatever you want as you go back home.
11. For security purposes, the parents will not be allowed in the children's tents or camps.
12. To maintain order at the field, parents will not be allowed to draw close to children's demarcated performance areas.
13. Children are not supposed to go back home with the house girdles/straps. We keep them at school.
14. Parents are encouraged to wear canvas or flat shoes to avoid damaging the field carpet.
15. The school will be launching her new album at the function. Parents are kindly requested to support the school by buying the album at 50,000/= per flash and 20,000/= per CD. Interested parents should book with the teachers before the sports day.

PS I: Children who use the school transport scheme will not be transported to & from the Sports gala venue. Respective parents are advised to arrange transport for their children.

PS II: Cubs and Brownies are expected to come wearing their club uniforms and black shoes. Please pack the children's sports wear in their bags. After marching, parents should help them to change into their sportswear for other activities.
