### **Re: End of Term II 2025 Parents' Circular**

Greetings from the Management, Staff and Children of Kampala Kindergarten Association (KKA). We thank the Almighty God for enabling us to successfully complete Term II 2025 today, Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2025. We congratulate and thank you dear parents for your continued support in all the school programmes. As we break off for the holidays, we wish to communicate the following to you:

#### **1. END OF TERM II 2025**

##### **a. Children's Progress Reports**

Every child has been given an End of term II Progress Report. Please study your child's report carefully and if there are any issues of concern, kindly approach the Class Teacher, Deputy Head Teacher or Head Teacher for clarity. In case the teacher has indicated or recommended something in the child's report, we request you to address it for the good of the child.

##### **b. Holiday Motivation Work**

All children have been given Holiday motivation work to help them revise the taught concepts. Please, encourage your child to do the work under the supervision of a responsible person and return it at the beginning of term III 2025 for marking. The Holiday Motivation work includes a project work section which the child has to read carefully and embark on at the beginning of the holiday in order to complete it in time. The parents' encouragement and guidance is very vital in this aspect.

##### **c. Children's Files**

Your child's paper-work has been filed in his/her file. You are advised to help your child revise the taught concepts and do revision using the filed papers. We request the Parents to off load and return the files at the beginning of Term III.

#### **2. TERM II ACTIVITIES**

##### **a. Class photos**

The school took Class photos from 16<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2025. Every child was expected to take a copy for home records at a cost of Ugx 2,500/= only. Those of you who have not yet picked these copies from the teachers, are requested to do so at the beginning of Term III, 2025.

##### **b. Education Trips**

As a way of exposing children to a wider environment, the school organized Education trips for all the children from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2025 to the Uganda Wildlife Education Centre - Entebbe. We thank parents for the contribution of Ugx 20,000/= towards the entry fees.

In addition to the general trips, different classes conducted trips to different places in the interest of consolidating the taught concepts. We thank the KKA drivers who transported the children and the teachers who organized the trips. We thank parents who sign the consent papers in time and continue to remind others that apart from the activities that are well outlined on the daily class Timetable, we do not take any child out of school without the parent's consent

##### **c. Open week**

The school organized an Open week from Monday 14<sup>th</sup> to Friday 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 with the purpose of giving parents an opportunity of checking on their children's progress. Parents who did not turn up are advised to create some time during the holidays to have a physical interaction with the teachers to discuss the child's progress and forge a way forward.

##### **d. Science Fair:**

The school organized a Science fair on Saturday August 9, 2025 under the theme "Let's Get Committed to Growing more Crops for Good Health and Wealth." This was an extract from the year theme; "Commiment leads to Excellence." We wish to register our appreciation to you for the support which was expressed in your class contributions

and the turn up in such big numbers. Special thanks go to the Guest of Honour **Mr. Tom Omara from National Crops Resources and Research Institute**, for accepting to preside over the function despite his busy schedule.

I would like to recognize the classes which emerged the winners of the Science Exhibition; Class 5B at the Blue level, Class 3A at the Green Level and class 1B at the Red level. The overall winner was Class 3A followed by Class 5B and Class 7B respectively. We thank the teachers, children and support staff for their tireless and selfless effort towards the success of the event. A victory party was organized for the winners and the rest of the children, as you know at KKA everyone is a winner.

### **Primary One Examinations:**

While the Day Care and Nursery sections children at KKA are not subjected to examinations, the Primary One children are introduced to examinations right from Term 1. They are supposed to do atleast three sets of examinations in a term namely: Beginning of term (except for Term 1, one set of Mid Term tests, Two sets at the End of every term (Internal and External).

### **3. GENERAL ISSUES**

#### **a. Children's Health**

There has been mild cough and colds that resulted into high temperatures among some children. This brought about irregular attendance of school by some children. We thank the parents who have been co-operative whenever called upon to pick their sick children for further treatment.

#### **b. School Fees**

The school dues have remained the same; Tot's Palace 1,300,000/ per term, Primary one - Normal Programme (half day) **1,112,000/=**, Day Care Programme (full day) **1,392,000/=**, Nursery section - Normal Programme (half day) **1,112,500/=**, Day Care Programme (full day) **1,392,500/=**. All school dues are paid in the bank before the beginning of the term. No child will be allowed in the classroom before full payment of fees is made. Please be informed that you can only pay cash for the following: clubs, lunch, late pick-up, extra uniforms, lost/spoilt library book and diaries, for which you have to get a receipt. Post-dated cheques are not accepted by the school any more.

#### **c. School Transport Scheme**

Parents with children on the Transport scheme are requested to pay the term's charges before the service is delivered. There are 55 school days in term III 2025. The money has been calculated and indicated on the bank slip.

#### **d. Admissions for 2025 & 2026**

We wish to inform you and the general public that we are still enrolling children for the academic year 2025 in all classes. We also call upon Parents who wish to enroll their children with us for the academic year 2026 to pick, fill and return the application forms before the end of September 2025. The interviews will take place in October 2025. **N.B** We wish to thank the parents who have entrusted us with their children in the Primary section and gladly inform you that we have continued to expand our Primary section up to primary two for the academic year 2026. We encourage the parents of the Blue level to apply for primary one intake, 2026 and request you to inform relatives and friends who have children of Day care, Nursery, Primary one and Primary two on our behalf.

#### **e. Amazon Club:**

As usual, the club will be operating during the holidays from Monday to Friday starting on Monday August 25, 2025 from 9:00am to 5:00pm, for all levels (Yellow, Red, Green, Blue and the Alumni/siblings who are below 12 yrs of age). This club has two programmes namely:

1. Half day (9:00am -12:30pm) at **Ugx: 120,000/=** (includes a break meal but no lunch).
2. Full day (9:00am – 4:00pm) at **Ugx: 160,000/=** (includes break and lunch meals).

Children in this club who will require assistance with their Holiday motivation work, shall be requested to pay an extra fee of **Ugx 20,000/=** for the KKA children and **Ugx 50,000/=** for the non- KKA children. However, the Saturday swimming lesson is still available at **UGX 5,000/=** from 10:00am to 12:00pm. Interested parents are called upon to register at the front desk.
