a) Thanksgiving for 74 years of excellence

b) Interviews for 2026 Entrants

While we are still enrolling children for the academic year 2025 in all classes, we wish to inform our Parents and the general public that we shall officially conduct interviews to enroll children for the academic year 2026 on **Sat. 11th Oct. 2025**. Interested parents are required to pick, fill and return the application forms before **Wed. 8th Oct. 2025**.

N.B:

1. We wish to inform the parents of Blue Level that our Primary one class has performed very well in a stress-free environment; and for that matter, please consider entrusting us with your child at the Primary One Level 2026, you will not regret it. Children of Primary One currently shall gladly be enrolled for Primary Two next year.

2. Night care services:

We are pleased to inform you all and the general public that KKA officially started night care services in response to the consistent requests by some parents most especially those that have night shifts at work. Interested parents are requested to visit the school front desk for details.

c) Open Week

This term's Open week shall take place from **Mon. 20th – Fri. 24th Oct. 2025** and it is mainly organized for promotion purposes. Depending on the child's progress, both the class teacher and the parent will agree on the appropriate class of promotion for the child.

d) Swimming Gala

The KKA Swimming Gala is scheduled for **Fri. 21st and Sat 22nd Nov. 2025**. The Gala will run under the theme; **We Commit to Keep Physically Fit by Swimming Regularly**. The Tots' Palace, Reds and class 3A will showcase their swimming skills according to their classes on **Friday 21st September 2025**. Classes 4C, 4B, 4A, all the Blues and Primary one will compete in their houses on **Saturday 22nd September 2025**. Parents are invited and encouraged to turn up in big numbers to support the little ones.

e) End of Year Concert

f) End of Year Children's Party and Graduation

The End of Year Children's Party and Graduation will be held on **Fri. Nov. 28th 2025**. Details will be communicated later.

g) The KKA Kids' Boom Camp

In reference to our End of Term II, 2025 circular, the school is organizing a KKA Kid's Boom camp which will take place from **Tue. 9th to Sat. 13th Dec. 2025** at the school. It will involve training through activities like; Games, Self-help Skills, Survival Skills, Morals and Religious Values (Christianity and Islam). The activities shall be clustered and conducted according to the children's age group. The camp is organized for both KKA and non KKA children between 3- 12 years. Parents who will find it difficult to drop and pick their children on a daily basis are advised to register for a boarding programme. Interested parents are requested to register their children for the camp starting now.

Kindly take note of the following:

a) Corporate Social responsibility

As a way of teaching our children how to embrace the gesture of sharing and supporting those in need, KKA continues to express the commitment to support those in need most especially the children. This year, we shall donate Toys to the children of **Sister Tereza Babies Home at Nsambya**. The Catholic based home rescues and takes care of children of 1 day – 2 years of age. Since most of them are toddlers, we thought of enhancing their play by donating to them toys so that they can also enjoy their childhood and develop to their potential just like other children. We therefore call upon parents to encourage your child to identify one appropriate toy from their collection at home and give it out to the children in the Babies home. Thank you in advance for supporting the cause and God bless you.

b) Kampala Capital City Festival:

This is to inform you dear parents that KKA was among the schools that were invited by Kampala Capital City Authority to participate in the major activities of the Festival. In that regard, some of our children shall have a presentation at the main event on **Sunday, 5th October 2025** at the Kololo Independence grounds. More details shall be communicated to the participants.

c) School dues:

We thank the parents who have paid all the school dues in time. Parents with balances are expected to clear by the end of September 2025 to enable us run the school activities smoothly.

d) Pick-up of Children:

For security purposes, we do not permit a person who has not been formally introduced to the school to pick up a child. We therefore, remind every parent to pick up his/her child's personal secret number for use in case of an emergency that may require sending someone else.

e) School Transport Scheme:

The school runs a Transport scheme for parents who find it hard to drop/pick their children. However, while the school vans are not supposed to work as taxis, it was found out that some drivers load them with passengers especially in the evenings after dropping the children at home. We request you to report any van that you may suspect to be misused to the Head

Teacher on Tel. no. 0754087386/0772037857 /0702129916. We thank the parents who have come up boldly to report incidents of the school vans' misuse which puts our children's lives at risk.

f) Sick Children:

In order to control the spread of infectious diseases among the children, you are reminded to leave the sick children at home. Please note; the school gives First Aid where need be and isolates the sick child until he/ she is picked by the parent to go for medical check-up and further management. We also remind you that the school does not allow children to come with medicine. In case of any special treatment to be accorded to the child, it has to be approved by the school Administration.

g) Diaries and Clear bags:

The school provides every child with a Clear bag and a School diary to ease communication between home and school. While a used-up diary is replaced by the school, a parent pays 2,000/= to the school bursar for a lost/spoilt diary. Kindly note that the school does not replace/sell clear bags for whatever reasons.

h) Birthday parties:

Parents are allowed to celebrate children's birthdays at school for 30 minutes between 12:00 noon to 12:30 p.m. However, for proper management, the parent is required to inform the teachers two days before the birthday. In order to cater for children's nutritional needs, we continue to inform parents that sodas and other packed juices should not be included on the birthday menu. Special Fresh juice for birthdays is prepared at school at a cost of 40,000/- per 5 litre jerrycan.

i) Library Books:


