#### RE: END OF TERM I - 2025 PARENT'S CIRCULAR

Please allow me on behalf of the staff and Management of KKA to briefly communicate the following issues to you:

### 1. END OF TERM I REPORTS & HOLIDAY MOTIVATION WORK

Every child has been given her/his end of Term I 2025 report. Please study your child's report carefully and if there are any issues of concern, do not hesitate to bring them to the attention of the Class Teacher, the deputy Head Teacher or the Head Teacher.

All children have been given holiday motivation work which is supposed to be done in bits under the parent's/ guardian's guidance. Children who have been given project work should start on it early enough in order to complete it and be able to submit it at the start of Term II 2025.

# 2. HIGHLIGHTS OF THE JUST CONCLUDED TERM

#### a. Orientation Week

This was conducted from Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> January to 4<sup>th</sup> February 2025 for the new children to enable them interact with school environment before the reporting back of the continuing children. The week was crowned with an orientation meeting for the parents of the new children on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> February 2025. The week must have done miracles for the teachers of the new children because by the end of it, most of them had realized that school was fun and crying on arrival had greatly reduced. New parents in the school were also helped to fit in the system.

#### b. Curriculum Week

This was conducted from Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> to Friday 7<sup>th</sup> March 2025. Parents were taken through the details of the curriculum expectations at the different levels of learning; the theme of the year 2025 was also introduced respectively as "Commitment Leads to Excellence" Parents and teachers discussed and agreed on each party's roles as regards to the new theme. Of the suggested greeting slogans, the teachers selected, 'I am Fine and Committed to Excel'.

#### a. Open Week

The school conducted a Parents' Open Week from Monday 24<sup>th</sup> to Friday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2025. ## d. Annual General Meeting

The meeting took place on Saturday April 26, 2025. We thank the parents who endeavoured to register as members and those who went ahead to attend the Annual General Meeting. A good number of school issues were discussed and resolutions were recorded in minutes to mention but a few;

- 1. An increment of Fifty thousand shillings only (50,000/-) was added to the school fees to cater for the rising costs of the school commodities.
- 2. KKA children will be wearing crocks while at school for easy movement and for hygienic purposes, as it will be easy for them to remove the crocks as they enter classrooms.

#### a) Admissions

No child will be allowed in class before all dues are paid. Please pay through the bank (**Bank of Africa**) using the given bank –slips, Bank drafts or school pay services. No school fees will be received in cash.

#### d) Transport Scheme

Parents on the scheme have been given bank slips to pay before the service is offered. Transport charges are 14,000/= for long route (pick and drop), 12,000/= for short route (pick and drop), 8,500/= for long route (pick or drop) and 7,500/= for short route (pick or drop). No child will be transported on credit.

### e) First Aid Uniforms

These uniforms are given to children who soil their school uniforms. All parents who have not returned the First Aid uniforms by the close of the term are requested to keep them safely and return them at the beginning of Term II 2025. We also request you to return any property that could have been packed in your child's bag by mistake at any one time. The owner may be desperately looking for it.

### f) Club

We would like to thank parents who have supported the KKA clubs this term. We however request parents who have not yet paid subscription fees for their children's clubs to so before the beginning of next term.

We remind parents that the Amazon club operates during holidays and it will start its activities on 5<sup>th</sup> May 2025. The club will operate from Monday to Friday from 9:00am to 5:00pm at 160,000/= inclusive of break and lunch meals. The club uniform costs 60,000/=per child. ## g) Secret numbers

This is a number which is used by a parent in case he/she wants to send someone who is not officially introduced to the school to pick up a child. Parents who have not yet picked their children's secret numbers are encouraged to pick them next term for convenience and safety of the children.
